

Consent Agreement


This consent agreement is made as of the 17th day of November 2016 between CIT Utah, Inc., a Utah 501(c)(3) corporation (CIT Utah) and CIT International, Inc., a Tennessee 501(c)(3) corporation (CIT International). Collectively, CIT Utah and CIT International may be referred to as "the Parties."

Ron L. Bruno is a Founding Director of CIT Utah and a Founding Director of CIT International. Ron L. Bruno is currently the Executive Director of CIT Utah with full rights and authority to conduct the business of CIT Utah. Ron L. Bruno is also the 2nd Vice President of CIT International with full rights and authority to conduct the business of CIT International.

1. The Parties share a relationship and common interest in developing Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) programs. CIT International's interests are to aid in the development of CIT programs throughout the world by working with communities and organizations that share the same interest. CIT Utah's interests are to provide support for the development of CIT programs within the communities of the State of Utah. There is no conflict of interests between the Parties as both rely on each other for success of their missions.
2. The Parties have been utilizing their individual logos to represent their individual organizations. The Board of Directors of CIT Utah and the Board of Directors of CIT International decided independently to secure trademarks of their organization's respective logos.
3. Ron L. Bruno filed the trademark application on behalf of CIT Utah on the 11th day of May 2016 under serial number **87032897**. Ron L. Bruno filed the trademark application on behalf of CIT International on the 20th day of May 2016 under serial number **87044684**.
4. The Parties recognize and acknowledge the common components the logos share as being the letters "CIT" and the words "Crisis Intervention Team" as both organizations share the same interests of promoting Crisis Intervention Team programs.
5. The Parties do not believe that there exists any confusion between them, their marks, and their respective interests. The Parties have coexisted with each other and with numerous other organizations throughout the world that have used similar logos containing the letters "CIT" and the words "Crisis Intervention Team" for over eight years.
6. The Parties believe that the variance of colors, design, and the wording of "Utah" and "International" are sufficient to allow the understanding that the CIT International logo (serial 87044684) represents only the organization of CIT International and that the CIT Utah logo (serial 87032897) represents only the organization of CIT Utah.
7. This agreement is binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the Parties and their respective successors and assigns.

The Parties hereby execute this Consent Agreement as of the date above.
